As we sometimes have difficulty obtaining hospital and hospital-related bills or must pay to obtain them, please forward a copy of all medical bills related to your treatment for this accident to our office immediately.

LIST OF INSTRUCTIONS

- ✓ Keep a record of all expenses. Get receipts or bills for all medical, hospital, drug or dental services.
- ✓ Send all receipts and/or bills directly to this office as soon as received.
- ✓ Keep records of dates of all absences from employment.
- ✓ Notify this office when you note any new physical difficulty.
- ✓ Keep a diary, listing all complaints each day and a record of missed activities due to the accident, e.g., missed bowling, missed golf, etc.
- ✓ Notify this office immediately upon change of address or telephone number.
- ✓ Forward all correspondence about your case directly to this office and notify us immediately if anyone contacts you about the case. If anyone calls you regarding this accident, give them our name and telephone number. Do not talk to them.
- ✓ Text me at 215-220-6310, if any problem arises.
- ✓ **DO NOT TALK TO ANYONE WITH REFERENCE TO THIS CASE OTHER THAN YOUR OWN DOCTOR AND THOSE PEOPLE SENT FROM THIS OFFICE UPON PROPER IDENTIFICATION. THIS IS EXTREMELY IMPORTANT. EVEN IF YOU ARE NOT ASKED TO SIGN ANYTHING. SUCH STATEMENTS OR CONVERSATIONS COULD BE EXTREMELY DAMAGING.**
- ✓ Send all medical bills relative to your accident to us when you receive them. Our purpose is to protect your interests and bring about a fair and reasonable settlement in your case as soon as possible. Your cooperation is very important.



SOCIAL NETWORKING WEBSITES

If you belong to a public social networking account such as Facebook, Instagram, YouTube, Twitter, Google Plus, etc., I STRONGLY recommend you stop all communications on those sites until your claim has been resolved.

If you cannot do so, please take caution as whatever you write, post, have written or posted, will fall into the hands of the insurance company. It is now standard practice for insurance companies to obtain this information and it is usually obtained without your knowledge or permission. If you have such a site, you should immediately verify that all your settings are on PRIVATE (the highest setting possible) and nothing is public. Even with the highest privacy settings, anything that you post could still be visible and we advise that any posting be halted until your case is fully resolved.

Please DO NOT send any e-mails regarding your case to anyone except your attorneys. Please DO NOT enter insurance websites, participate in blogs, chat-rooms or message boards. Most importantly, do not allow anyone to become a friend on an account unless you are absolutely sure you know that person.

We have seen an increase in electronic surveillance of these account and sites by the insurance companies, investigators, and defense attorneys for purposes of embarrassing and humiliating claimants, and claiming your injury was exaggerated or even caused by anything other than the incident related to your claim. Insurance companies have successfully used such information; even those considered innocent, harmless joking between private friends to convince a judge and juries that plaintiffs have been dishonest. Please always be aware of what you say or post, including photographs, in any format on your computer or internet. Also, be aware that the insurance companies may be entitled to request all information contained within your home computers and laptop hard drives regarding the issues we discussed above therefore, please adhere to our advice.
